Please note: This workshop can be conducted in English or Cantonese. The student number of each session is around 15 (12 for 4-6 age group).					
A child of 4 once told me a story about a door. It opens, then it closes. It opens again and then closes. One more time, it opens and closes. It then decides to stay closed. Because it feels very tired. Writing poetry had always been something difficult for me until I decided I had to listen to what my heart told me, like the child listens to the door.
